The Order of Service:

Collect

Old Testament Isaiah 52:13--53:12,

Psalm 22:1-11

Epistle Hebrews 10:1-25

The Passion John 19:1-37

The congregation may be seated for the first part of the Passion. At the verse which mentions the arrival at Golgotha (John 19:17) all stand.
