# Church Bulletin Board!

Mid-Columbia Partners,

I am pleased to announce that MCCAC has closed on our purchase of the Oregon Motor Motel in The Dalles. This 54 room hotel purchase was made possible by a grant from the Oregon Community Foundation through its Project Turnkey 2.0 program. Over the coming months the motel, to be titled "The Annex" (in connection with The Navigation Center), will be converted to transitional shelter and housing that will provide approximately 100 beds to Hood River, Wasco and Sherman County community members who are experiencing housing instability or houselessness. A portion of these 100 beds will be utilized for transitional family shelter/housing, which is currently a resource gap in the Mid-Columbia Region. MCCAC is also partnering with multiple agencies to ensure those housed at The Annex have access to the resources needed to thrive. These partner agencies include the Mid-Columbia Center for Living (MCCFL), the Oregon Human Development Corporation (OHDC), The Next Door, Nch'I Wana Housing, Mid-Columbia Medical Center, Providence Hood River Memorial Hospital, One Community Health, Columbia Gorge Health Council and Bridges to Health. MCCAC will also be completing a major rehab of The Annex and we hope to have the facility beautified and opened by the middle of 2023.

Over the coming weeks, MCCAC will be working with the Oregon Community Foundation to make a public media announcement around this project. We are waiting until that coordinated announcement to conduct any press events on the project. For now, if you or community members have questions about The Annex, we have set up a webpage with a project overview and a frequently asked questions section. A Note from the Next Door: Hygiene kits are the most utilized items in the Drop-in center for youth we serve. I am extremely grateful for your support to the program.

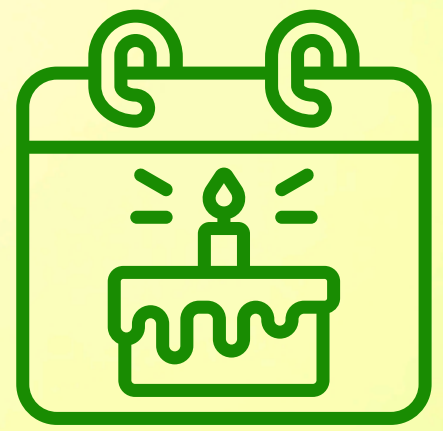
